2. Old Business:
 - a. See ClickFix at Paddock Ln near Steere St. SGT Brillon to investigate if it qualifies for a stop sign at a T intersection.
 - b. Roberts St. at 13th: complaint is it is the only intersection on Roberts that isn't a 4 way stop, leading to confusion at this intersection.
 - c. See Click Fix opened to DPW: Resident asking for a stop sign on Teaberry Ln. at the intersection with Slater St.
 - d. Resident complaint to DPW: Pothole on No. Main St. at Elizabeth St. Will recommend to use See Click Fix.
 - e. Resident complaint to DPW: no crosswalks on rte 152 between West St. and Holcott St.
 - f. Question from DPW: is there a process for removal of permanent speed humps?
 - g. Request to allow on street parking on Angeline St.
 - h. Request to bar traffic turning left onto Newport Ave. from May St.
3. New Business brought forward by the Traffic Study Commission
 - a. H&L Bloom, the school bus contractor for the city of Attleboro, must relocate the location for the parking of 40 city school buses. They are in the planning stages to negotiate with LaSalette Shrine to use available parking which fronts Park St. Steve McDavitt of H&L Bloom is asking the TSC to review this plan and provide and thoughts, recommendations and concerns.
