PROGRAM YEAR 2015**

PURPOSE

The goals of the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) are to provide decent and affordable housing, to provide a suitable living environment, to expand economic opportunities and create employment opportunities for very low-income, low-income, and moderate-income persons and households, and augment social services. These can be accomplished through coordination among all levels of government, non-profit organizations, the private sector, and the citizens of the City of Attleboro.

CONTENT OF THE CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)

The draft PROGRAM YEAR 2015 CAPER (year 2 of the 5-Year Consolidated Plan) serves as an annual report outlining the year's accomplishments of the City's CDBG Program, which is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This CAPER covers the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 in which the City received \$374,286.00 in CDBG funds to carry out the goals and objective as set forth in the CONSOLIDATED PLAN and ANNUAL ACTION PLAN.
