The *Expo for the Senses* includes the Attleboro Arts Museum, Attleboro Jewelers, entertainers, and local restaurants to work together to create Attleboro's Expo for the Senses. You will hear music, see jewelry, smell and taste food, and see art. Experience the wide variety of ethnic foods prepared by local city restaurants while artists, musicians and other performers entertain you. Children will be able to enjoy a special area that will highlight a series of hands-on interactions with local educators, naturalists, and City Police/Fire representatives.
