

COMPOST CENTER: Yard waste can be dropped off at the Compost Center at 29 Pond St North. The Center is open April through November with the exception of Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, and Thanksgiving. The hours are Monday-Friday 12:30-3:30 and weekends 9am-3:00. Only leaves, grass, and yard waste including brush/branches will be accepted.

CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION: Leaves and yard waste collected during the following weeks on the assigned trash day: November 6-10 2023, December 4-8, 2023, April 8-12, 2024, and May 6-10, 2024. Please use paper yard waste bags, cardboard boxes, or barrels with the cover off. No plastic bags will be accepted.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION: Curbside collection during the week of January 8-12, 2024 on the assigned trash day. All ornaments, lights, tinsel, plastic bags must be removed.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY: Saturday August 26, 2023 and May 4, 2024, 9am-1pm at 29 Pond St North. Oil Paint/Aerosols **will be accepted**. No Latex Paint.

COMPOSTERS: Earth Machine composters can be purchased at the Recycling Center during normal business hours. The composters are \$37.19 payable by check or cash.

RAIN BARRELS: Rain barrels can be purchased at the Recycling Center during normal business hours. Rain barrels are \$85.00 payable by check or cash.

MERCURY RECOVERY PROGRAM: Bring household fluorescent bulbs, cell phone batteries, car batteries, and computer batteries to the Recycling Center. Mercury thermostats, thermometers, and cell phones can be brought to the Health Department.

KIOSK (NEEDLES AND SYRINGES): 24/7 drop off kiosk located at the 100 Union St Fire Station and the 1476 West St Fire Station. Needles must be placed in a 1 gallon sharp container. The container must fit in the kiosk.

AUTO WASTE COLLECTION: Saturdays 9am-1pm (during the months of April-November) at 29 Pond St North. Automotive waste, oil, oil filters, and antifreeze may be disposed. **No paint products.**

TEXTILE COLLECTION: For curbside collection, please complete a pickup request at www.helpsy.co/ pickup or by calling 800-244-6350. For a full list of acceptable items please visit the City's website. Also, a Bay State textile bin is located at the Recycling Center. Dry and clean clothing, linens, and shoes accepted.

MATTRESSES: Dry and bed bug free mattresses and box springs may be brought to the Recycling Center during normal business hours. Disposal is \$25 per item payable by check or cash. For curbside collection, contact the Health Department for more information.

BOOKS: Books may be dropped off in the Baystate Book bin at the Recycling Center during normal business hours.

TIRES, PROPANE TANKS, FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: May be brought to the Recycling Center for disposal during normal business hours. Fees: Tires \$5 - \$20 per tire (depending on size), fire extinguishers \$5/unit. Propane tanks are accepted at no additional charges.

CARDBOARD: Curbside: Flattened and cut to fit in recycling toter. Drop off: At Recycling Center during normal business hours.

BROKEN CARTS/TOTERS: For damaged or broken carts/toters call (508) 223-2222 ext 3253/3245.

SWAP SHED: The Swap Shed allows residents to give away or adopt gently used items while keeping them out of the waste stream. It is open during normal business hours at the Recycling Center.

TRASH

CARTS

All trash must be placed in the City issued blue 35-gallon cart. The lid must be closed. Overfilled carts will not be collected. Carts should be placed out for collection between 5pm on the day prior to collection and 7am on collection day. Carts must be removed on day of service. Carts must be placed at the curb with a four foot clearance.

OVERFLOW BAGS

Excess trash that cannot fit in the 35-gallon cart must be placed in City bags, which can be purchased for \$10/roll of 5 bags. There is no limit to the amount of bags that may be placed out for collection. Bags can be purchased at CVS Pharmacy, Walgreens, Emory Convenience, Market Basket, Seabra Supermarket, Shaws, Stop & Shop, and Willow Tree Poultry Farm.

RECYCLING

BULK: For bulk disposal please contact Waste Management to schedule a curbside appointment by calling (800) 972-4545 or by logging on to www.wm.com.

BULK AMNESTY WEEKS: 4 small bulk items may be scheduled for pickup during the following weeks on the assigned trash day: August 28-September 1, 2023, January 22-26, 2024, and May 20-24, 2024. Appointments must be made prior to the Thursday proceeding the scheduled week. Call (800)972-4545 to schedule an appointment. For a full list of acceptable amnesty items please see the City's website.

METAL/ ELECTRONIC ITEMS: Call (508)822-1579 to schedule a curbside pickup. Items are picked up every week with an appointment. Items must be placed out by 7am. Items accepted include: appliances, metal, computers, and electrical devices. All items must be drained of any gas or oil. These items may also be brought to the recycling center.

TELEVISIONS: Residents must obtain a sticker at the Health Department for disposal. Limit of 1 tv sticker per fiscal year. Additional stickers are \$25 for each tv. For curbside pick up, call (508) 822-1579 to schedule an appointment. TVs with a sticker can also be brought to the recycling center.

PAINT DISPOSAL: Oil paint and aerosol cans are now accepted only on Household Hazardous Waste Days. Latex paint can be dried out and put in a bag in your trash.

SCHEDULE

Your trash cart, bulk item, recycle receptacles, and contained overflow bags may be placed curbside for weekly collection between 5PM the evening before and 7AM the morning of your scheduled collection. Missed pick-up? Call (508) 223-2222 ext 3253 or 3245.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE: Pick-up will be delayed by one day on the day of the following holidays and for the remainder of the week: Fourth of July - July 4, 2023, Labor Day - September 4, 2023, Thanksgiving -November 23, 2023, and Christmas-December 25, 2023. New Years Day – January 1, 2024, Memorial Day, May 27, 2024.

Recycling is mandatory in Attleboro! All recyclables must be loose in the container. No plastic/paper bags or wrap! Styrofoam of any kind and black plastic is **not** recyclable. Questions on what can be recycled? Visit www.recyclesmartma.org.
